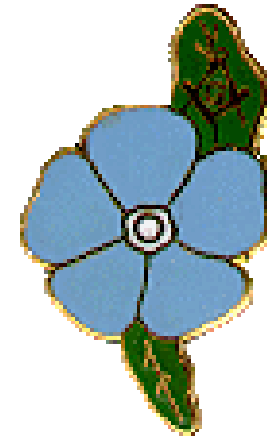

FYI The blue lodge or regular lodge has a number of appendant or concordant bodies- organization that a Mason may join if he is interested or that his wife might join. These are organizations who's base their membership on membership or relationship with the blue lodge. Locally we are familiar with the Scottish Rite but there are many more. The following is a partial list with notes. Altor Veritatis found in Louisiana only, Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, Bishop Wilkins College (Trinitarian Masons in England), Daughters of the Nile (Must be related to a Shriner), Felicitaries (French body general considered to be irregular), Grand College of Rites, Holy Royal Arch, Knights Templar (York or American Rite in US or United Religious Military and Masonic Order of the Temple & St. John, Rhodes and Malta-UK), Order of Quetzalcoatl (Shrine membership required), Order of Amaranth (female only), Order of the Eastern Star (coed), Order of the Golden Chain, Swedish Rite (Scandinavian organization), Tall Cedars of Lebanon (social organization mostly in the eastern portion of the US), Mystic Order of Veiled Prophets of the Enchanted Realm (Grotto), Philalethes (Masonic Research Society), Royal Order of Scotland (requires 18th degree of Scottish Rite Europe 32 degree US and one of the "Christian Orders), Mark Master Mason, Royal Ark Mariners Red Cross of Constantine (2 version US and UK systems are different), National Sojourners,.
