When a man makes a promise with evasion that means he is eluding or avoiding the terms of the promise; and this is done, or it is attempted to be done, by equivocation, which is accomplished by giving to the words a secret significance that is different from that which they were intended to convey by the person making the promise so as to mislead, or by a mental reservation. This is saying one thing but meaning another, which is a concealment of certain conditions that the promiser does not share with the promisee. Making a promise a person has no intention to keep violates the law of veracity. When someone promises us something we trust him, but if later we have a feeling he made the promise, all the while not intending to keep it, then we may be doubt his veracity.
